These positions require high scholarly achievement, high proficiency in writing and editing, and strong organizational and "people" skills. Graduate assistants work 20 hours per week at DePaul's Lincoln Park and/or Loop Campuses. Work schedules, which change from quarter to quarter, are flexible enough to accommodate the student's classes and other personal responsibilities. The work calendar runs from early September until Thanksgiving and from early January until early June, with a two-week spring break in late March.
